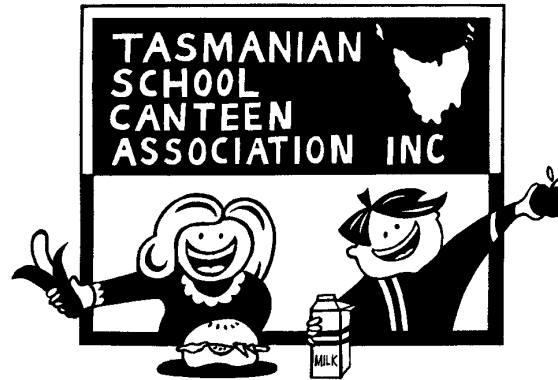
TSCA Background

The first executive was elected in May 1995 with statewide representation comprising canteen managers, representatives from Parents and Friends Associations, the Heart Foundation, and the Department of Community and Health Services.

TSCA Mission Statement

To promote and facilitate the provision of a nutritious and healthy food service in school canteens

Objectives of the TSCA.

- ❖ To provide advice and support to school communities on the operation of school canteens.
- ❖ To assist school canteens to provide food consistent with the Australian Dietary Guidelines.
- ❖ To encourage school canteens to support the nutrition education curriculum in their schools.
- ❖ To provide nutrition information and resources to school canteens.
- ❖ To establish a set of recommendations for use in school canteens throughout Tasmania, the basis of which shall be good nutrition, and safe, hygienic food preparation (Cool CAP).
- ❖ To liaise with food producers to ensure a supply of healthy food choices to school canteens.
- ❖ To liaise with Department of Education and the Department of Health and Human Services to ensure that the Departments policies are consistent with the Tasmanian School Canteen Association directions.
- ❖ To encourage all school canteens to become members of the TSCA.
- ❖ To work in partnership with State School Canteen Associations.

- ❖ To encourage members to gain training and or qualifications appropriate to the management of a school canteen.
- ❖ To perform all other tasks to achieve the above objectives of the TSCA

How to join T.S.C.A.

There are four membership categories:

Individual Membership:

A person who supports the aims of the association.

Individual members are entitled to one vote.

School Community Membership:

A person nominated by a school community who supports the aims of the association. Not more than two members per school community.

Each school community is entitled to two votes.

General Membership:

An association, agency or relevant non-profit organisation that supports the aims of the association, but not eligible for individual, school or corporate membership.

General members are entitled to one vote.

Corporate Membership:

An organisation or agency that supports the aims of the association but not eligible to apply for individual, school, or general membership.

Corporate members are not entitled to vote.
